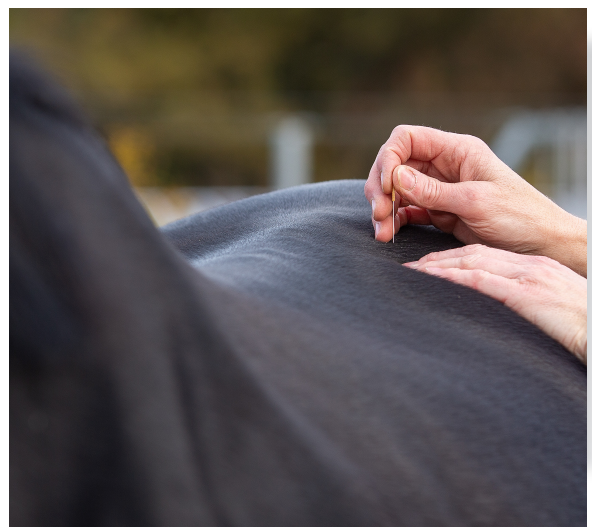

The Certified Veterinary Acupuncture program provides a comprehensive training curriculum in acupuncture tailored specifically for veterinarians and veterinary students. The certification for small animals is divided into three distinct levels. The certification for horses consists of two levels. Veterinary students may enroll in each level of the Acupuncture Program after completing their first, second, and third years of the DVM program, respectively. Enrollment is capped at five students, with places allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Graduates of the DVM program receive CEBVAsa or CEBVAeq certification after obtaining their veterinary license. A 20% discount and a payment plan are offered. The lead instructor for these programs is Bonnie Wright, DVM, DACVAA, CVMA, CVPP, CCRP, CCRT.
